AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapters 14, 30 and 78 of the Municipal Code regarding applications and permitting of Theaters, Game Rooms, Peddlers and After-Hours Business' in conjunction with the New EnerGov Permitting and Licensing System.

SYNOPSIS:

Changes to the Municipal Code to allow applications for Theaters, Game Rooms, Peddlers and After-Hours Business' Permits to be submitted online in the EnerGov Permitting and Licensing System and removal of the requirement to collect social security number, date of birth and signature.

- The City Clerk's Office is reviewing several license/permit processes and application forms and making the necessary changes to allow online submittal in the new Energov Permitting and Licensing System. This software replaces the 20-year old Tidemark permitting software.
