

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2019 Sewer Repair Contract 1, 08-2019-011. The improvement includes the construction of storm sewers, manholes, intakes, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, seeding, sodding, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 607-087/116 at the following locations: Lynner Drive and Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, 3301 Parkside Drive, Park Avenue and South Union Street, Woodland Cemetery, intersection of Vermont Street and Indiana Avenue, Waveland Golf Course, Lincoln Place Drive and River Oaks, 2525 Clarkson Street, DM III east of North Valley Drive, and various other locations all in Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$1,750,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
