### AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Hubbell Avenue and East Broadway Avenue Intersection Improvements: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Sonny E. Hall, President, \$819,458.20.

### SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Hubbell Avenue and East Broadway Avenue Intersection Improvements and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The intersection improvements include replacement of antiquated traffic signal equipment and improvements to capacity and safety of the intersection. The proposed improvements include adding a second left-turn bay on East Broadway for westbound to southbound traffic and geometric improvements to provide safer merge for northbound to eastbound turning traffic.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$819,458.20 Construction Contract (\$600,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

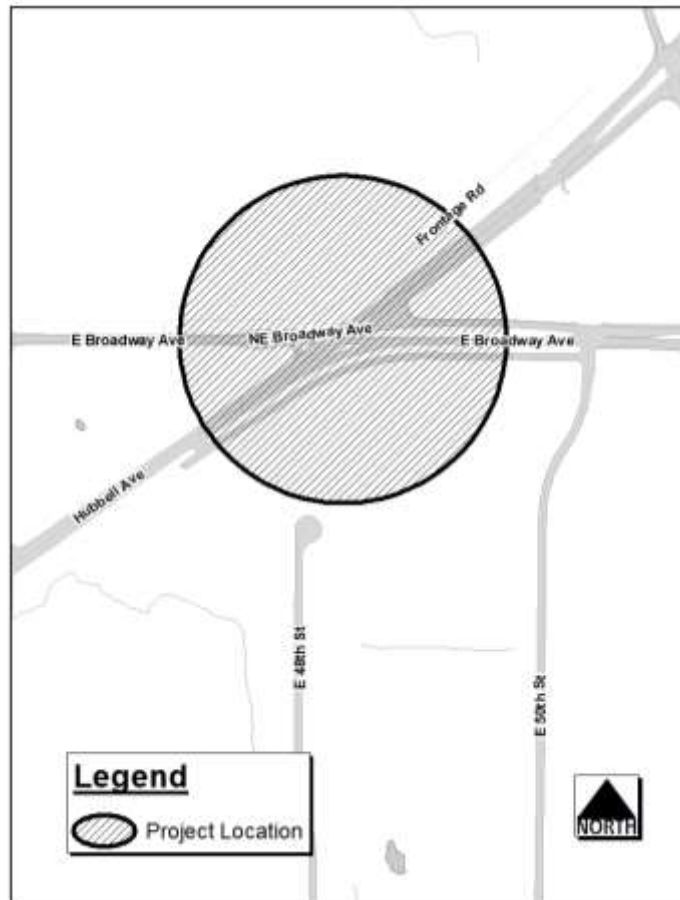
Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Street – 12, Hubbell Avenue and Broadway Intersection Improvements, ST273, Being: \$145,000 (Max) in Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Traffic Safety Improvement Funds under CS-TSF-1945(842)--85-77; \$200,000 (Max) in IDOT Urban State Traffic Engineering Program (USTEP) Funds (55% of eligible items with a max of \$200,000) under agreement 4-19-USTEP-008; and the remaining \$474,458.20 in G.O. Bonds issued, ST273.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On April 22, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-0619, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Hubbell Avenue and East Broadway Avenue Intersection Improvements. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Hubbell Avenue and East Broadway Avenue Intersection Improvements, 06-2018-015. The improvement includes reconstruction of the Hubbell Avenue and East Broadway Avenue intersection including a new westbound left turn lane, full-depth Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement widening, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement overlay, pavement scarification

and removal, HMA surface patching, PCC curb and gutter, pavement markings, 24-inch Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) storm sewer, intakes, manholes, new traffic signals and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 609-117/158, located at Hubbell Avenue and East Broadway Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Slater, IA
  - TK Concrete, Inc., Pella, IA
  - Iowa Civil Contracting, Inc., Victor, IA
  - Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA
  - Minturn, Inc., Brooklyn, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on May 7, 2019.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Absolute Concrete Construction, Inc., Sonny E. Hall, President, 505 1st Avenue, Slater, IA, 50244 in the amount of \$819,458.20, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
