AGENDA HEADING:

Authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary property interests for the 2nd Avenue Reconstruction – University Avenue to the Des Moines River Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary right-of-way and easements for the 2nd Avenue Reconstruction – University Avenue to the Des Moines River Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the property acquisition process under eminent domain.


FISCAL IMPACT:

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- There will be a mix of total acquisitions, partial acquisitions and temporary construction easements needed along the corridor affecting approximately 52 properties.
- Currently, there are several properties that are listed for sale along the project corridor that have been identified as total acquisitions for the project.
- This authorization will allow the City to initiate the acquisition process for total acquisitions, which normally require substantially more time to complete the acquisition, relocation and demolition processes.
- Certain total acquisitions will be required no matter if the ultimate roadway cross-section is 4-lane or 5-lane.
- The acquisition of all other property interests for the project will be initiated after preliminary design is complete and acquisition limits have been determined.
