### AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Amendment #4 of Contract for the Single-Stream Recyclables Processing Services with Mid America Recycling, LLC (formerly known as Midland Recycling-Lincoln, LLC).

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend Council approval of amendment to contract between the City of Des Moines and Mid America Recycling, LLC and authorizing the City Manager to execute amendment to the processing contract with Mid America Recycling which provides for a revised performance bond from \$1,000,000 to \$500,000 which has been approved as to form by the Legal Department. Also Exhibit A shall be amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with fee schedule to include processing fee to \$65 per ton, to mirror Metro Waste Authority recycling contract.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Projected fee \$500,000 annually.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Public Works Department provides a number of services including the curbside collection and processing of recyclable materials. The Public Works Department entered into a processing contract with Mid-America Recycling, LLC under Roll Call No. 08-1271, dated July 14, 2008. The contract allowed for an initial 7-year period beginning December 6, 2008 and ending December 31, 2015, with up to two (2) additional 5-year renewals at the City's discretion.
- On February 8, 2016, by Roll Call No. 16-0213, the City Council approved a Third Amendment to Contract which provided for a revised performance bond allowing an annually renewing bond, which was approved by Legal Department.
- On May 18, 2015, by Roll Call No. 15-0828, the City Council consented to assignment of the Contract by and between the City of Des Moines and GreenStar Mid-America Recycling, LLC for Single Stream Solid Waste Recyclables Processing Services for the Public Works Department to Mid America Recycling, LLC and authorized the City Manager to execute an amendment on behalf of the City to the Contract.

- On December 7, 2015, by Roll Call No. 15-2064, the City Council approved a renewal and second amendment to the contract, which, among other items, renewed the term of the contract until December 31, 2020, and required a performance bond to be provided with a term the same as the contract term length.
