T.M. Franklin Cownie (R-5) Mayor, to Pristina, Kosovo and Bonn, Germany from June 23 – June 28, 2019. The purpose for this travel is to sign the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Pristina Mayor, which will become the working agreement for projects and programs between Sister Cities Des Moines and Pristina. Also, to attend the 10th Resilient Cities Congress and ICLEI Global Executive Committee meetings in Bonn Germany to discuss the state of local resilience and the progress made in the past decade as the North American Regional Representative and ICLEI Vice President. Hotel accommodations in Bonn will be provided by ICLEI.

Roger Nowadzky (R-1) Chairperson, to Pristina, Kosovo from June 23 – June 27, 2019. The purpose for this travel is to sign the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), which will become the working agreement for projects and programs between Sister Cities Des Moines and Pristina.

The amended budget for travel and training in Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 is \$753,416. The amount expended for travel and training in FY 2019, as of May 24, 2019, is \$453,014.87.
