**Jeremy Eekhoff (NR-0) Fire Protection Engineer**, to Phoenix, AZ from October 13 – October 18, 2019. This is the premier fire protection engineering conference in the United States. The event hosts a unique number of professional development and training opportunities from some of the most qualified professionals in the industry and are required to maintain/renew employees Professional Engineering License.

**Scott Sanders (R-0) City Manager**, to Vancouver, Canada from July 17 – July 21, 2019 to attend the Annual Summer Large Cities Executive Forum. Participants will have the opportunity to discuss key issues affecting large cities.
