AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of grant agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding of the City's Fifth Year (2019) Action Plan of the 2015-2019 HUD Consolidated Plan.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend Council approval of grant agreements by and between HUD and the City of Des Moines, whereby the City will receive Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership program (HOME), and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding (grant awards) for the implementation of the Fifth Year (period of January 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019) Action Plan of the 2015 - 2019 HUD Consolidated Plan.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$4,929,990

Funding Source: FY 2019-2020 Operating Budget, Community Development: Special Revenue Funds, Community Development Block Grant Fund, Page 61; HOME Fund, Page 61; Homeless Fund, Page 61.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- At the City Council meeting on November 5, 2018, the Council approved the Fifth (2019) Year Action Plan of the 2015-2019 HUD Consolidated Plan consisting of CDBG, HOME, and ESG funding. From 2018 to 2019, funding for CDBG has decreased by \$34,192, funding for HOME has decreased by \$76,921, and funding for ESG increased by \$6,858. The Grant Agreements must be processed in order to receive the City's entitlement funding for these programs.
