AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 102 of the City Ordinance to implement best practices at street use events.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of amending Chapter 102 of the City Ordinance to implement best practices at street use events including deliveries to businesses during an event, cleanup measures and denial of a future street use event due to excess disruptions during an event including noise and placement of accessory items.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- City staff and the Greater Des Moines Partnership staff conducted several meetings recently to develop a list of best practices to be followed at all street use events. Several areas were discussed and the following are the recommended amendments to Chapter 102:
 - Amend section 102-1125 to require that a map or diagram of proposed locations of food stands, generators, dumpster, trash receptacles, temporary restroom facilities, or any other noise or odor generating item proposed to be used.
 - Amend section 102-1128.2 to allow access to all businesses within the closure for deliveries up to one (1) hour before the event opens. Also, service trucks, which are present for the event, shall not block entrances to businesses.
 - Add section 102-1128.3 Clean up required. All trash and litter shall be cleaned up in the permitted street closure area and within a 1-block radius of the permitted street closure area upon the end of the event. All grease spills on the street that occur during the street closure shall be cleaned off if not prevented with protective coverings.
 - Amend Section 102-1130.10 to include denial of a street use permit if the sponsor, applicant, their employees or agents have not followed all conditions which may have been placed on a prior street use permit including, but not limited to, the placement of potential noise and/or odor generating items or have caused excess noise and/or odors at past events.
