## AGENDA HEADING:

Amount: Minor costs for sign removals.

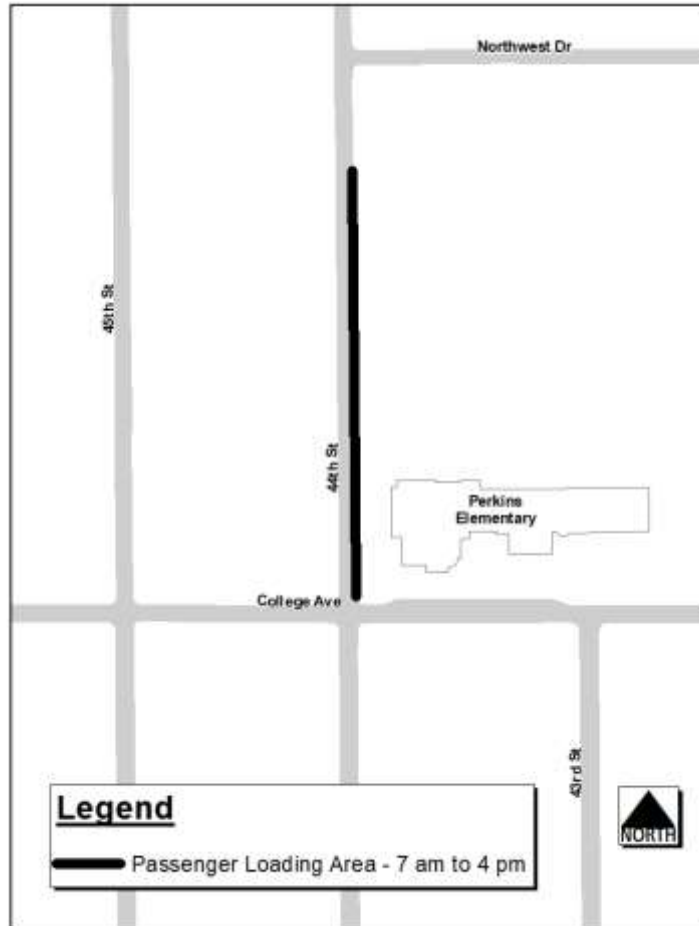

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. The Des Moines Public Schools changed the school arrival and dismissal times for the 2018-2019 school year. In order to accommodate the earlier start times at elementary schools, the City adjusted the passenger loading zone times adjacent to those schools. The Principal of Perkins Elementary brought to staff's attention that the signs had not been changed on 44<sup>th</sup> Street north of College Avenue. The proposed code modifications will change the existing passenger loading zone start time from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m. This is consistent with the changes made at other schools last year.

Sec. 114-2931. Forty-fourth Street--Dead end south of Grand Avenue to Ovid Avenue.

Forty-fourth Street, on the east side, from College Avenue to a point 600 feet north thereof, passenger loading and unloading, 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., school days.
