AGENDA HEADING:

On the proposition to authorize a lease purchase agreement in the principal amount, not to exceed \$120,000, for the purpose of acquiring four (4) Nissan Leaf hatchback electric vehicles.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the proposition of a lease purchase agreement of 24-months leases, with an option to purchase, for four (4) Nissan Leaf Hatchback Electric Vehicles. These vehicles will be used by inspectors in the Community Development Department for the Blitz on Blight Program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$120,000 (principal amount not-to-exceed with 24-month lease and optional buyout)

Funding Source: 2019-2020 Operating Budget, page 103, I201, Equipment Replacement Fund

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City Facilities Division is planning for the infrastructure to charge these vehicles. Mid-American Energy is giving the City a \$1,500 rebate for the charging stations that will lessen the cost of the infrastructure costs. The dual stations cost \$3,500 and with the rebate it comes to \$1,000 per vehicle charging spot (four {4} spots - \$4,000). The cost of installation of the two (2) stations are estimated at a total of \$8,000-\$10,000.
