AGENDA HEADING:

Approving agreement for fueling, repair, and maintenance services with the Des Moines Independent Public School District (DMPS).

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of a fueling, repair, and maintenance services agreement with DMPS to fuel, repair, and maintain gasoline vehicles and heavy-duty diesel trucks at City facilities. The agreement does not include school buses.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$16,000 net revenue, based on estimated repairs and fuel use.

Funding Source: 2019-2020 Operating Budget, page 99, Equipment Maintenance Center Fund, I010, FN024020

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City has been providing fueling services to DMPS gasoline vehicles of cars, pickups, and vans- “white fleet” since 2010. The new agreement provides fuel, fuel dispensing, repair, and maintenance for the DMPS white fleet and fleet of heavy duty diesel trucks used in the delivery of meals to schools from the central kitchen facility. Services will be provided to approximately 100 vehicles under this new agreement; however, all school buses will still be fueled and maintained by DMPS.
