AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the fiscal year (FY) 2019 Annual Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the Federal Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification Report for FY 2019. This annual report is a requirement for the Police Department's participation in the sharing of federal asset forfeiture funds and has been prepared for submission to the Department of Justice (DOJ) who administers the program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Revenue varies from year to year depending on the activity. In FY 2019, the revenue from forfeited funds generated was \$340,280.

The department expended \$154,814:

- \$98,364 was expended on departmental training and instruction
- \$56,450 was expended on the Fallen Officer Memorial

Funding Source: S321, PD225000, federally forfeited funds

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This report verifies proper use of the federal asset forfeiture funds in accordance with the Department of Justice rules and regulations for equitable sharing for local law enforcement agencies. Equitable sharing of federally forfeited funds may only be used for activities that enhance law enforcement. Funds may not be used to replace or displace the resources of the law enforcement agency.
