### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

**Joe Gatto (R-0) Councilmember**, to Denver, CO from October 16 – October 18, 2019. To tour and research Denver revitalization districts with urban planning experts. The goal is to enhance knowledge of the opportunities for strategic Market District redevelopment.

**Anna Whipple (R-0) Chief Information Officer**, to Pontianak, Indonesia from September 28 – October 9, 2019. In May 2019, the City IT Department hosted a professional fellow from West Kalimantan Provincial Government, Indonesia. This trip is a reciprocal exchange sponsored by the American Council of Young Political Leaders (ACYPL), the U.S. State Department and the U.S. Embassy of Indonesia to continue to develop relationships and learning opportunities between the U.S. and Southeast Asian governments. This trip will focus on sharing best practices for IT governance, centralization, and application. Expenses are mostly covered by ACYPL.

The budget for travel and training in Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 is \$845,441. The amount expended for travel and training in FY 2020, as of September 13, 2019, is \$56,333.23.
