AGENDA HEADING:

Acceptance of proposal from MidAmerican Energy Company to remove and replace streetlights at the intersection of Hubbell Avenue and E. Broadway Avenue, not to exceed \$96,222.87.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend acceptance of proposal from MidAmerican Energy Company, 200 SE 3rd Street, Des Moines, IA 50309, to remove existing streetlights and replace them with new steel galvanized streetlight poles at the intersection of Hubbell Avenue and E. Broadway Avenue, not to exceed \$96,222.87, to accommodate the new intersection improvements currently being constructed at this location.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$96,222.87

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Streets-12, Hubbell Avenue and Broadway Intersection Improvements, ST273

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Hubbell Avenue and E. Broadway Avenue Intersection Improvement project includes the removal of existing streetlights and installation of new galvanized streetlights. Included in the proposal, is the installation of underground electrical lines at the intersection.
- The proposal provides for MidAmerican Energy Company to install 13 streetlights on 12 galvanized street poles and on one (1) existing wood pole.
- This work will be performed by MidAmerican Energy and is budgeted as part of the Hubbell Avenue and E. Broadway Avenue Intersection Improvement project costs. The estimate from MidAmerican Energy for the relocation work is \$96,222.87.
