AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with McClure Engineering Company for professional services for Ingersoll Avenue - 42nd Street to Polk Boulevard, not to exceed \$218,230.

SYNOPSIS:

Approving the PSA with McClure Engineering Company (Troy Jerman, Principal-in-Charge, 1360 NW 121st Street, Clive, Iowa, 50325), for a total cost not to exceed \$218,230, based on hourly rates, to provide design phase services for the roadway rehabilitation of Ingersoll Avenue – 42nd Street to Polk Boulevard.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$218,230

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Streets-22, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Ingersoll Avenue from 42nd Street to Polk Boulevard needs pavement rehabilitation. The street is proposed to be rehabilitated by cracking and seating existing pavement and installing a HMA overlay and new PCC curb and gutter. Sidewalks and driveways within the corridor will be replaced. The scope includes development of three (3) alternative concepts for the cross section to accommodate drive lanes, bike lanes or a trail, center left-turn lane and parking.
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) for professional services for Roadway Reconstruction – Ingersoll Avenue was issued and posted on the City’s website. A selection committee of Engineering Department staff reviewed and rated the 10 proposals received, in response to the RFP. McClure Engineering Company was selected based upon the selection criteria in the RFP and their project approach and similar previous experience.
- Staff has negotiated a PSA with McClure Engineering Company for a total cost not to exceed \$218,230, based upon hourly rates, for design phase services for Ingersoll Avenue – 42nd Street to Polk Boulevard.

ANTICIPATED ACTIONS AND FUTURE COMMITMENTS:

City staff does not anticipate any future Council actions on this PSA at this time; however, unanticipated changes to this PSA will require a Supplemental Agreement, which may require Council action. The City may need assistance from the consultant for construction phase services, which would require another agreement or supplemental agreement.
