AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 102 of the City Ordinance to require notification of street use events to business and neighborhood associations and to require minimum payment of police service if a street use event is cancelled.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of amendment to Section 102 of the City Ordinance requiring street use event applicants provide notice to business and/or neighborhood associations of a street use event lasting more than one (1) hour. Further recommend approval of amendment to Section 102 requiring street use event applicants pay the minimum two (2) hours of police service if a street use event has been cancelled and police officers have reported to work the event.

FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Amend Section 102-1125 requiring street use event applicants provide notice of a street closure for a special event lasting more than one (1) hour to respective business or neighborhood associations.
- Amend Section 102-1131 requiring street use event applicants to pay the minimum two (2) hours of police service if a street use event has been cancelled and police officers have reported to work the event.
