### AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the Chapter 28E Agreement by and between the City of Des Moines, Iowa and the City of Norwalk, Iowa for a Public Improvement Project, Echo Valley Drive from Old Highway 28 to Norwalk corporate limits.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Chapter 28E Agreement between the City of Des Moines, Iowa and the City of Norwalk, Iowa for the coordination of funding for the design and construction for Echo Valley Drive.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$150,000

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Street-25, Roadway Rehabilitation - Collector, ST217, Gaming Monies

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City of Norwalk, in coordination with the City of Des Moines, has developed a project to resurface Echo Valley Drive from Old Highway 28 to Norwalk corporate limits. A portion of the roadway is in the boundary between the City of Des Moines Corporate Limits and Norwalk Corporate Limits, requiring improvements to be developed in a coordinated manner. The City of Des Moines is the lead agency for this project and will be performing design and construction management. The proposed agreement requires the City of Norwalk and the City of Des Moines to share in the project costs based on the jurisdictional ownership of the roadway.
- The project will consist of milling, patching, and a hot-mix asphalt overlay to strengthen the existing hot-mix asphalt pavement. The project is scheduled to be completed by the end of 2020.
- The City of Norwalk approved this 28E Agreement at its October 17, 2019 Council meeting.
