### AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase and installation of a sewer cleaning and maintenance equipment bodies on three (3) heavy-duty truck chassis for use by the Department of Public Works from Gradall Industries Inc.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the purchase and installation of a sewer cleaning and maintenance equipment bodies on three (3) recently awarded heavy-duty truck chassis from Gradall Industries Inc., (9102 NE 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Vancouver, WA 98665, Mike Hoverman, President) utilizing the Sourcewell purchasing contract No. 122017-GRD in the amount of \$841,216.08.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$841,216.08

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Three (3) existing heavy-duty truck chassis with sewer cleaning and maintenance equipment bodies that meet or exceed replacement criteria were approved for replacement by the Fleet Oversight Committee. The equipment for these “Catch Basin Cleaners” provides a dual purpose of vacuuming and jetting sewer lines.
- This recommendation is consistent with the previous award based on competitive comparisons of multiple brands from multiple contracts. Gradall Industries can provide three (3) additional Vacall brand equipment bodies under the Sourcewell contract that are identical to the single existing unit in use by the Sewers Division. The recommended purchase will enhance fleet consistency in repair, maintenance, and increase operational efficiencies.
