### AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement for resurfacing 2nd Avenue (Iowa 415) from Euclid Avenue to N.W. 72nd Place.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of IDOT Agreement No. 2020-4-027 for resurfacing 2nd Avenue (Iowa 415) from Euclid Avenue to N.W. 72nd Place. The IDOT will construct hot mix asphalt resurfacing utilizing IDOT funds, at an estimated cost of approximately \$3,900,000. The City will only be responsible for the costs of sanitary and storm sewer manhole adjustments and spot replacement of curb and gutter within City limits from Euclid Avenue to Aurora Avenue, estimated to be \$64,000.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$64,000

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Street Improvements–22, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260, Road Use Tax

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The IDOT is planning a mill and overlay project in 2020 on 2nd Avenue (Iowa 415) from Euclid Avenue to N.W. 72nd Place, a portion of which is in City limits from Euclid Avenue to Aurora Avenue. The IDOT will maintain traffic during construction of this project.
- The IDOT will be the contracting authority responsible for the construction of the project. Night work will be allowed with no jack hammering between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. The IDOT is responsible for notifying all residents and businesses along the roadway, within City limits, of the work and the time frame for construction.
