### AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of Hewlett-Packard, Inc., (10801 Farnam Drive, Omaha, NE, 68154, Dion Weisler, President) computer equipment using contracts established by the State of Iowa General Services or Department of Transportation, which have been competitively bid.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for the Information Technology (IT) Department to purchase computers from Hewlett Packard for replacement of existing computers using State of Iowa contract pricing. The Procurement Administrator has determined that the pricing has been competitively bid and is available to the City via State of Iowa Contract 16055A

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$28,665

Funding Source: Fiscal Year (FY) 2020 Operating Budget, Information Technology, Page 138, IT153000, User Services

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This approval will allow the IT Department to use budgeted funding to continue to replace outdated computer equipment. The City will utilize the State of Iowa pricing agreement for Hewlett Packard equipment. This approval pays for the next phase of replacements within the amount budgeted for FY2020.
