### AGENDA HEADING:

Approval to accept the 2019 Justice Assistance Innovation Grant (JAG) award through the Office of Drug Control Policy in the amount of \$37,500. This award has a performance period of December 16, 2019 through October 31, 2020 and does not require a match.

### SYNOPSIS:

The Police Department was notified of the grant award on December 16, 2019. The award will purchase software licenses and technical support for a 2-year term. The software is designed to assist law enforcement with more efficient and effective search, recall and analysis of case-related data. The program can sort through large quantities of information and identify related or common information in cases, social media and cell phone data. The grant does not require a match and has a term from December 16, 2019 through October 31, 2020.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$37,500

Funding Source: Special Revenues and Other Funds on page 211 of the FY2020 Adopted Operating Budget, Department Detail.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The 2019 JAG Innovation grant through the Office of Drug Control Policy will support a 2-year subscription for the software, Leads On-Line. This software is designed solely for law enforcement to assist with data mining on the web, analyzing large quantities of data such as cell phone information and cross-referencing individual names to identify common information and associates on cases across the country. The program allows on-line reporting for pawn shops and secondhand stores to add to the extensive data base to allow search criteria for stolen items to be more effective and efficient. The program will store and refresh previously searched information giving notification, if matching information is found.
