AGENDA HEADING:

\$20,000 funding to Polk Soil & Water Conservation District to support water quality monitoring in Fourmile Creek and Walnut Creek watersheds.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend one-time approval to provide funds, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000, to Polk Soil & Water Conservation District to support a 3-year study underway with Drake University to provide water quality information, which will help assess the impacts of watershed management activities in both the Fourmile Creek and Walnut Creek watersheds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This water quality monitoring study was recommended by both the Fourmile Creek and Walnut Creek Watershed Management Authorities (WMAs), both of which the City is a member.
- The total estimated cost of the 3-year study is approximately \$200,000. The remainder of the funds are being provided by contributions from other members of the WMAs, as well as Des Moines Waterworks.
- The WMAs will be provided with the complete dataset of:
 - o All physical, chemical, and biological measurements
 - An analysis of the effectiveness of management actions to improve water quality parameters
 - A description of the factors that most strongly influence stream health across the three
 (3) distinct land uses in the Fourmile Creek and Walnut Creek watersheds
