### AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 42nd Street Reconstruction from Grand Avenue to Pleasant Street: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$616,036.38.

### SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 42nd Street Reconstruction from Grand Avenue to Pleasant Street and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the reconstruction of 42nd Street from Grand Avenue to Pleasant Street.

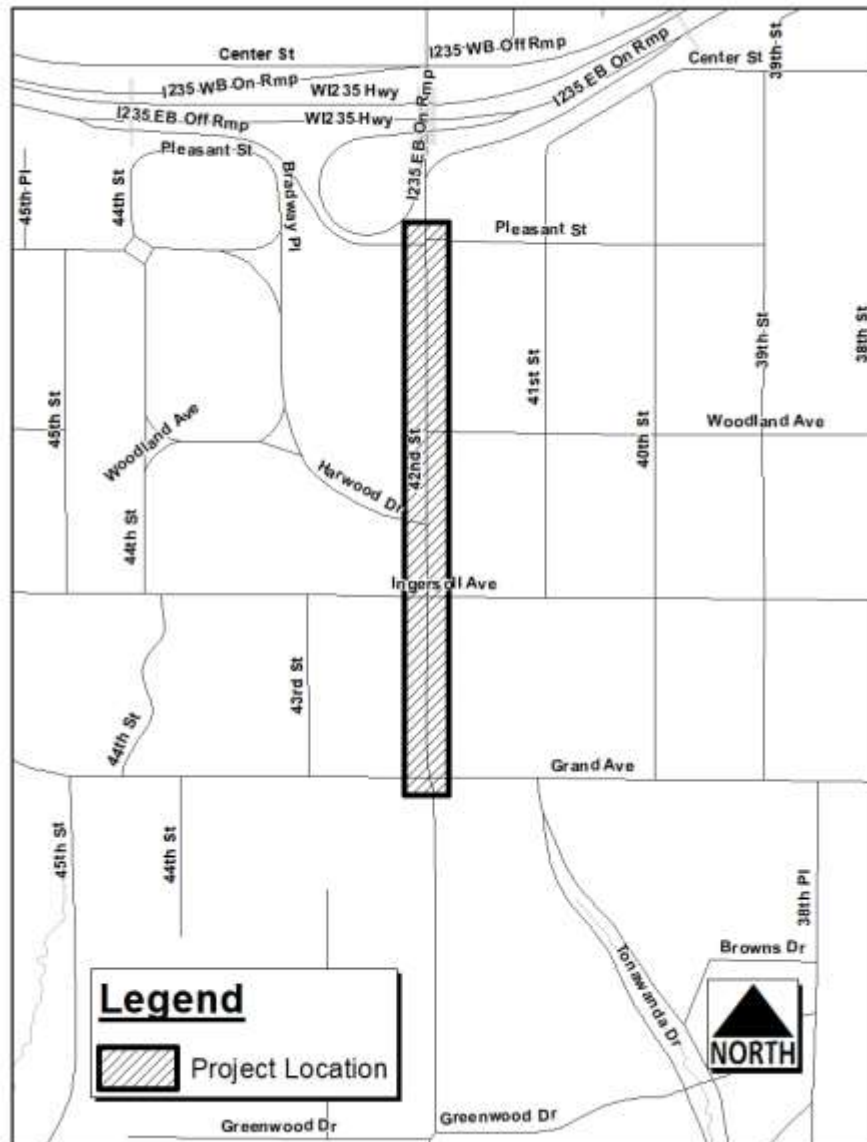

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On December 2, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-1897, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 42nd Street Reconstruction from Grand Avenue to Pleasant Street. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 42nd Street Reconstruction from Grand Avenue to Pleasant Street, 06-2019-008.
- The improvement includes the reconstruction of 42nd Street from Grand Avenue to Pleasant Street with new full-depth Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), pavement markings, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk ramps, 18-inch Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) storm sewer, intakes, sanitary sewer manholes, sodding, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 613-91/110, located at 42nd Street from Grand Avenue to Pleasant Street.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
  - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
  - MPS Engineers, P.C. d/b/a Kingston Services, P.C., Des Moines, IA
  - Synergy Contracting, LLC, Bondurant, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on December 17, 2019.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 in the amount of \$616,036.38, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
