AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Riverwalk Improvements - Paver Replacement - Receiving bids, (3-10-20), and Setting date of hearing, (4-6-20). Construction Estimate - \$400,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The improvement includes removal and replacement of deteriorated sidewalk pavers and associated work at the Riverwalk between Center Street and Vine Street along the west side of the Des Moines River.

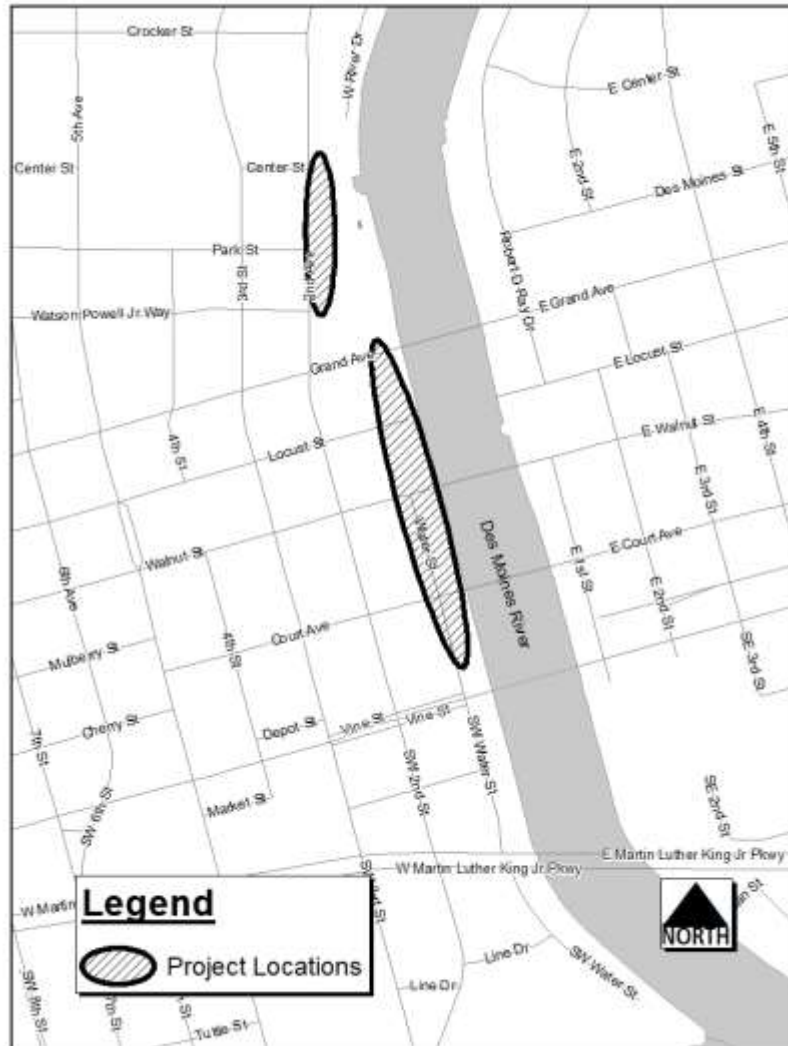
FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$400,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2019-2020 CIP, Page Park – 18, Principal Riverwalk, PK162, Being: \$150,000 G.O. bonds issued and \$250,000 G.O. Bonds to be issued.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Riverwalk Improvements - Paver Replacement, 04-2019-004. The improvement includes removal and replacement of deteriorated sidewalk concrete unit pavers, limestone pavers, and associated work; all in accordance with the contract documents, located along the Riverwalk between Center Street and Vine Street along the west side of the Des Moines River.
- The estimated construction cost is \$400,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
