AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement for Indianola Avenue Reconstruction: East Army Post Road to US 69.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of IDOT Agreement No. 1-20-STBG-SWAP-013 between the City of Des Moines and the IDOT for the Indianola Avenue Reconstruction: East Army Post Road to US 69.

FISCAL IMPACT:

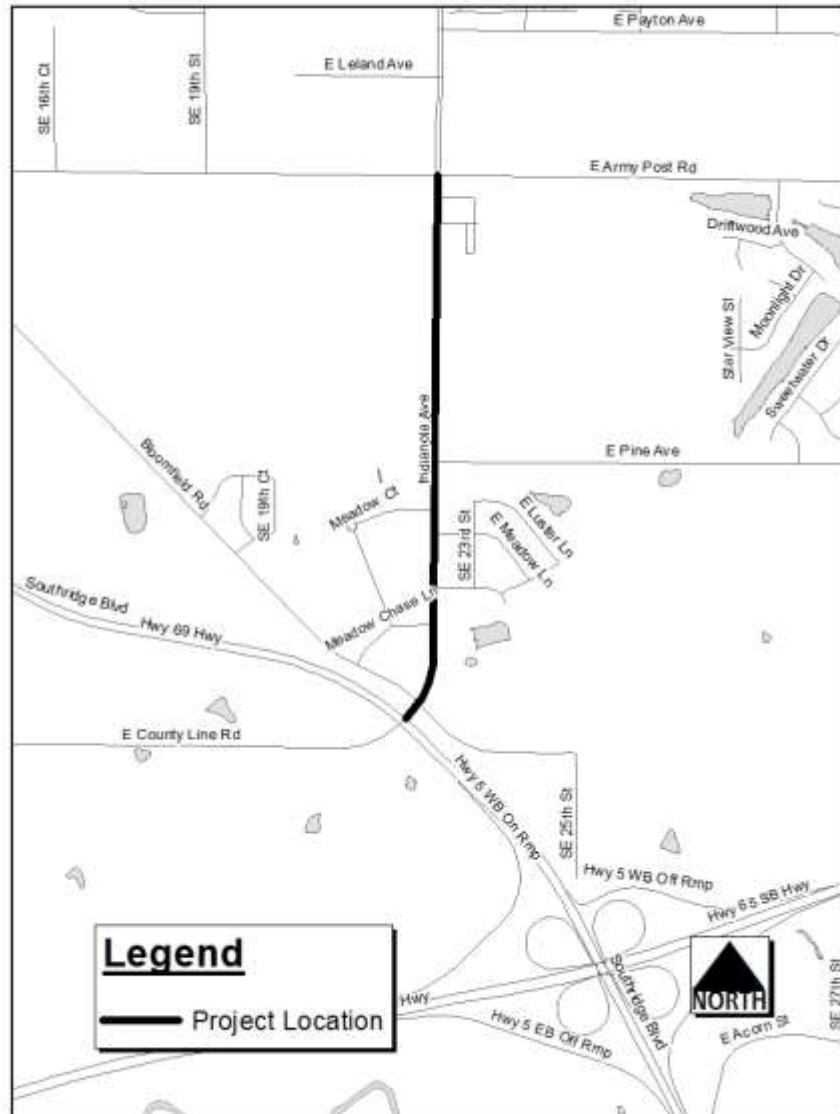
Amount: \$5,000,000

Funding Source: Various funding being:

- \$3,000,000 - Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program Federal-aid Swap funds
- \$2,000,000 - 2019-20 CIP, Page Street Improvements-14, Indianola Avenue Widening – E. Army Post Road to Highway 69, ST264, G.O. Bonds

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This project is the final phase of the five (5) phase Indianola Avenue Project and includes improvements between Army Post Road and US 69.
- The project will reconstruct Indianola Avenue as a 2-lane roadway with curbs and gutters and with the addition of possible left turn lanes at intersections depending on the traffic study. The project also adds a 10-foot wide multiuse trail along the west side and a sidewalk along the east side of the roadway.
- The estimated project cost is \$5,000,000.
