### AGENDA HEADING:

Request acceptance of the Anti-Heroin grant through the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy designated to reimburse law enforcement overtime associated with mid to high-level heroin investigations.

### SYNOPSIS:

The Police Department requests approval to accept a grant award from the Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy in the amount of \$7,777 with a performance period of March 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 and no match requirement. The funding is directed to support the law enforcement investigation of heroin related cases.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Police Department currently enters case related information into the Law Enforcement Intelligence Network (LEIN) database to provide information sharing with the State of Iowa Division of Intelligence and other law enforcement agencies. The LEIN system enables multiple agencies to effectively search and cross reference information on multiple cases.
- The Police Department has a strong record of grant compliance and performance. The Governor's Office of Drug Control Policy informed the City these grant funds are available for heroin investigations. The funds will reimburse the City for officer overtime costs incurred deploying LEIN database system and other investigative techniques between March 1, 2019 and June 30, 2020.
