### AGENDA HEADING:

Approval to purchase medical supply items via the Iowa Emergency Medical Services Association (IEMSA) agreement with Bound Tree Medical (Jeff Prestal, President), and the Minnesota Multistate Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP) cooperative, McKesson (Stanton McComb, President), Henry Schein (Stanley Bergman, CEO), Medical Solutions (Craig Meier, President) and Concordance (Lisa Hohman, CEO) for use by the Fire Department.

### SYNOPSIS:

The procurement code allows the use of the IEMSA contract per 2-726 (a) (5). IEMSA contract with Bound Tree expires July 31, 2022. The procurement code allows the use of the MMCAP cooperative contracts per 2-726 (m).
