### AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2020-2021 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing - Receiving bids, (5-5-20), and Setting date of hearing, (6-8-20). Construction Estimate - \$387,000.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the timely maintenance of residential and arterial streets utilizing surface scarification and HMA overlay to improve the surface condition, extend the useful service life of the streets, and to construct Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalk curb ramps within the project areas.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2020-2021 HMA Pavement Scarification and Resurfacing, 06-2020-006. The improvement includes scarification only of 2-inches average depth of asphalt street surfaces with specified milling machine and equipment in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines Public Works Department, together with other incidental and related work; all in accordance with the contract documents at the following locations within the City of Des Moines:

4th Street from University Avenue to Creighton Avenue

8th Street from Park Street to School Street

11th Street from College Avenue to Jefferson Avenue

15th Street from University Avenue to Keosauqua Way

16th Street from Carpenter Avenue to Clark Street

18th Street from Clark Street to College Avenue
