AGENDA HEADING:

Approve Second Amendment to January 7, 1974 Service Agreement between the State of Iowa Department of General Services and the City of Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Second Amendment to the January 7, 1974 Service Agreement between the State of Iowa Department of General Services and the City of Des Moines. The 1974 Service Agreement governs activities and sets lane mile rates for street maintenance and snow clearance on streets within the perimeter of the State of Iowa Capitol Complex. The Second Amendment provides an increase in the dollar amount the State of Iowa pays the City per lane mile for street maintenance and snow removal. The Second Amendment also adds street tree planting, maintenance, and removal in accordance with City street tree policy, at no cost to the State of Iowa.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$9,598 in revenue to increase 3% annually

Funding Source: FY2020-2021 Operating Budget, Page 234, Public Works Street Maintenance – S360 PW240402

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Second Amendment extends the existing agreement including annual price adjustments between the City and the State of Iowa for street maintenance and snow removal services until the year 2029.
- The Second Amendment provides for the first time, the ability of the City to plant, maintain, and remove street trees within the Capitol Complex. The City will deploy a normal level of resource to further the 3% canopy increase goal set by the Iowa Department of Natural Resources for all Iowa municipalities. No compensation is required of the State of Iowa.
