#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hold public hearing on the intent to commence a public improvement project to construct the Southeast Connector – SE 30th Street to U.S. Highway 65 Project and to authorize acquisition of the necessary property interests, including agricultural land, for the project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of authorization to proceed with acquisition of the necessary property interests, including agricultural land, for the Southeast Connector – SE 30<sup>th</sup> Street to U.S. Highway 65 Project by gift, negotiation, or eminent domain. This action is required by Iowa law before the City can initiate the property acquisition process under eminent domain.

This project consists of extending the Southeast Connector from SE 30<sup>th</sup> Street to U.S. Highway 65. This project will require relocation assistance.



### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- This project will complete the Southeast Connector by extending it from SE 30<sup>th</sup> Street to U.S. Highway 65.
- On May 6, 2020, under provisions of Iowa Code Sections 6B.2A and 6B.2D, notices of the
  proposed resolution authorizing acquisition of agricultural land by eminent domain for public
  improvement purposes were mailed to each affected agricultural land property owner, contract
  purchaser of record and any tenants known to be occupying the properties required for the
  project.
- The affected property owners have the right to attend the City Council Meeting on June 8, 2020, and to voice any objections to the proposed acquisition of the properties.

• The acquisition of several total, partial and temporary property interests will be needed for the implementation of this project, the extent of which will be determined after design has been completed. Relocation assistance may be required for this project.
