## AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 6th Avenue Streetscape - College Avenue to University Avenue: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Hawkeye Paving Corporation, Anthony L. Perkins, President, \$4,565,307.

## SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 6th Avenue Streetscape - College Avenue to University Avenue and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project includes streetscape enhancements, roadway reconfiguration from five (5) travel lanes to three (3) travel lanes, improvements to pedestrian and bicycle facilities along the corridor, street tree planting, and constructing green infrastructure components such as biocells and permeable pavers.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$4,565,307 Construction Contract (\$3,867,486.70 City Engineer's Estimate)

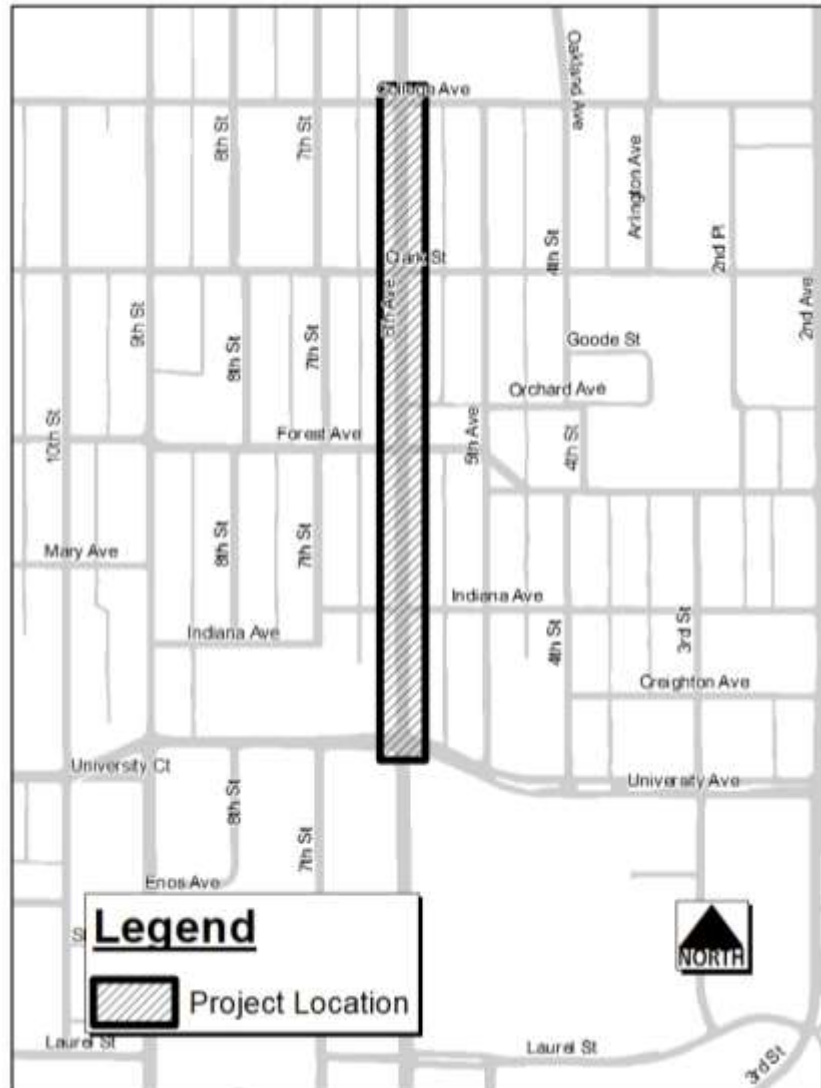
Funding Source: 2020-2021 CIP, Page Street – 41, Sixth Avenue Streetscape, ST266, Being: \$483,000 (maximum) in Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds being 80% eligible construction costs under TAP-T-1945(851)--8V-77; \$1,050,000 (maximum) in Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds being 80% eligible construction costs under TAP-T-1945(851)--8V-77; \$900,000 in private donations from the 6th Avenue Corridor; \$243,200 in Des Moines Water Works for water main relocation; the remaining \$1,889,107 in G.O. Bonds.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On May 18, 2020, under Roll Call No. 20-0807, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 6th Avenue Streetscape - College Avenue to University Avenue. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 6th Avenue Streetscape - College Avenue to University Avenue, 04-2018-017. The improvement includes pavement removals, installation of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalks and driveways, curb, storm sewer, intakes, subdrain, site furnishing, biocells, permeable pavers, traffic signalization, pavement scarification, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)

paving, tree planting, seeding, and miscellaneous associated work to complete the streetscape; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 618-001/152, on 6th Avenue from College Avenue to University Avenue.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
  - Hawkeye Paving Corporation, Bettendorf, IA
  - Jasper Construction Services, Inc., Newton, IA
- The bids, in accordance with a previously approved Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement, were received and opened by the IDOT on June 16, 2020.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Hawkeye Paving Corporation, (Anthony L. Perkins, President, 801 42nd Street South, Bettendorf, IA, 52722) in the amount of \$4,565,307, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
