AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of Public Safety replacement vehicles for use in the Police Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the approval to purchase 19 replacement public safety vehicles for use by the Police Department as follows:

- Eighteen (18) Ford Utility Interceptors (Patrol) as per contract State contract number MA005 19154 from Stivers Ford, 1450 E. Hickman Road, Waukee, Iowa 50263 (Scott Politte, General Manager) in the amount of \$585,376.
- One (1) cargo van utilized for prisoner transport as per State contract number MA 19097 from Dewey Ford, 3055 SW Delaware, Ankeny, Iowa 50021 (Dan Boettcher, General Manager) in the amount of \$33,773.

FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$619,149

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Vehicles in the Police Department fleet were identified that meet or exceed established replacement criteria and approved for replacement by the Fleet Oversight Committee (FOC) in a multi-year plan. New vehicle classes were matched to the same vehicle class as the existing units being replaced and any upgraded classes were approved by the FOC. Pursuit rated SUVs were further identified as the optimum vehicle class and approved by a previous additional FOC process for the designated use; therefore, there is not opportunity for alternative fueled (hybrid, plug in hybrid, or electric) vehicles or to downsize in vehicle class.
- Bid responses to recent annual vehicle bid solicitations have continued to diminish in previous years. Based on responses from area commercial fleet managers of vehicle dealerships the reasons for reduced responses include:
 - Individual policy decisions not to compete with awarded State of Iowa Contract holders as the contract holders are afforded manufacturer discounts for State Contracts that are not available to all dealerships.

- Discontinued manufacturer's discounts for governmental and municipal sales.
- \circ Multiple dealerships under the same owner will not submit bids for competing product brands.
- Requirement for bidding dealers to source specialized up fitting of service bodies and vehicle accessories that cannot be performed at their respective dealerships.
- Vehicles meeting specifications necessary to deliver City services are available from various State of Iowa Department of Administrative Services vehicle purchasing contracts. Therefore, the recommendation is to award the purchase of vehicles to the respective State contract holders as indicated.
