AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of purchase of maintenance and support for the City's server hardware and virtualization software with OneNeck per the competitively bid State of Iowa Master Agreement 005 16054C.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of purchase of maintenance and support from OneNeck IT Solutions (8401 Greenway Boulevard, Middleton, WI 53562, Terry Swanson, President and Chief Executive Officer), per NASPO VP - HPE MNNVP-134, State of Iowa Master Agreement 005 16054C, which is competitively bid. The maintenance agreement is effective until June 30, 2021.

This maintenance and support covers the Hewlett-Packard server hardware located in the Information Technology (IT) Department data centers located at the Armory, Municipal Service Center and the Des Moines Police Department. Included in this agreement is annual support for backup tape libraries and VMWare (cloud and virtualization software).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Hewlett Packard servers are critical to the City operations, which provide the computing resources for which applications and services are needed for City staff to do their daily job functions. The backup tape libraries provide backup and recovery for all data files and folders.
- The maintenance agreement provides coverage for an essential part of the City's technology infrastructure.
- The agreement is for one (1) year, this will allow the IT Department the flexibility to adjust maintenance and support as hardware is retired year to year.
