

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- This project includes traffic signalization improvements throughout the City including the construction or replacement of traffic signal infrastructure, new or upgraded associated traffic control signage and the replacement of failed or obsolete signal equipment and detection.
- Signals planned for replacement in 2021 include the following intersections:
  - o 6th Avenue and Holcomb Avenue
  - 42nd Street and Grand Avenue
  - 56th Street and Grand Avenue
  - SE 5th Street and Indianola Avenue
- This project is on-going and property acquisition requirements will be determined as traffic signal projects are designed.
- Any additional property rights needed generally consist of minor temporary and permanent
  easements, or partial acquisitions with minimal acquisition costs. Relocation assistance will
  not be required for this project.
