AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

- A. Code Modification related to parking changes on E Vine Street, E Market Street, E Elm Street, SE 6th Street, and SE 7th Street due to the Rowat Lofts (110 SE 7th Street) and District at 6th (201 SE 6th Street) Developments.
- B. Proposed code change to match field conditions on the west side of 6th Avenue from Mulberry Street north.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Costs for sign installations and periodic maintenance of signs and markings.

Funding Source: 2020-21 Operating Budget, page 77 Engineering Department Traffic and Transportation—Sign, Painting, Signal and Lighting, EG062080.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. Two (2) developments in the Market District of the East Village, the Rowat Lofts at 110 SE 7th Street and the District at 6th at 201 SE 6th Street, have made changes to on-street parking on adjacent streets. The streets impacted include E Vine Street, E Market Street, E Elm Street, SE 6th Street, and SE 7th Street. The proposed code modifications are necessary to match the updated on-street parking modifications with the Municipal Code.



Sec. 114-361.01. (b) - Angle parking.

(9) Southeast Seventh Street, on the west side, from East Vine Street to East Elm Street.

(10) East Vine Street, on the south side, from Southeast Sixth Street to Southeast Seventh Street.

Sec. 114-2657. Southeast Sixth Street--East Vine Street to East Porter Avenue.

Southeast Sixth Street, on the west side, from East Vine Street to East Elm Street, no parking any time.

Southeast Sixth Street, on both sides, from East ~~Vine~~ Elm Street to Vale Street, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3180. East Elm Street--Southeast First Street to Southeast Thirty-sixth Street.

~~East Elm Street, on the south side, from Southeast Fifth Street to Southeast Sixth Street, no parking any time.~~

East Elm Street, on both sides, from Southeast ~~Sixth~~ Seventh Street to Southeast Tenth Street, no parking any time.

Sec. 114-3468. East Market Street--Des Moines River to Southeast Twenty-ninth Court.

East Market Street, on both sides, from Southeast ~~Sixth~~ Seventh Street to Southeast Eighth Street, no parking any time.

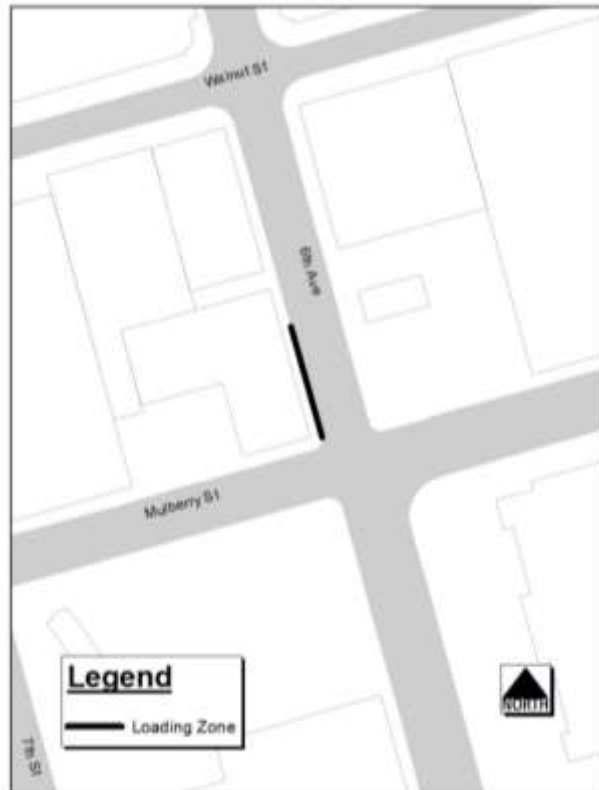
Sec. 114-3711. East Vine Street--Southeast First Street to Southeast Sixteenth Court.

East Vine Street, on both sides, from Southeast First Street to Southeast ~~Eighth~~ Sixth Street, no parking any time.

East Vine Street, on the south side, from a point 55 feet east of Southeast Sixth to a point 15 east thereof is designated a handicapped parking area and is subject to the same prohibition as is found in subsection 114-616(a) of this chapter.

East Vine Street, on both sides, from Southeast Seventh Street to Southeast Eight Street, no parking any time.

- B. In conjunction with the new inset constructed adjacent to the Aparium Hotel, the proposed code change will modify the Municipal Code to extend the loading zone on the west side of 6th Avenue.



Sec. 114-2640. Sixth Avenue--Mulberry Street to Walnut Street.

Sixth Avenue, on the west side, from a ~~point 100 feet north~~ of Mulberry Street to a point ~~45~~ 100 feet north thereof, ~~commercial~~ loading zone.
