AGENDA HEADING:

Approving purchase of an additional tracked asphalt paver for use by the Street Maintenance Division of the Department of Public Works.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the purchase of an additional tracked asphalt paver with appropriate accessories and a 5-year extended warranty for use by the Street Maintenance Division of the Department of Public Works for scheduled street improvements from Murphy Tractor and Equipment Company (Thomas Udland, President, 5087 NE 46th Avenue, Des Moines, IA 50317), in the amount of \$181,126 using Sourcewell purchasing contract number 032119-JDC.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$181,126

Funding Source: 2020-2021 Operating Budget, page 97, I201, Equipment Replacement

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This addition to the fleet of equipment for asphalt rehabilitation is smaller than the existing asphalt paver acquired as a replacement in 2012. The more compact design will allow more efficient completion of asphalt inlays street repair projects and reduce the waste of excess material experienced when the larger machine is used on smaller projects.
- The recommended purchase was the result of various evaluations and demonstrations of various models and brands by the using division and was approved as an addition to the to fleet by the Fleet Oversight Committee (FOC) and programmed into the multiple year vehicle and equipment replacement plan for the Street Maintenance Division.
