AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of Grant Agreements with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for funding revisions in the City's 2020 Action Plan as part of the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan.

SYNOPSIS:

There was a minor error in HUD's formula when it allocated the City's 2020 regular entitlement funds. Consequently, the City must sign new contracts for the 2020 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) with HUD reflecting the revised amounts.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Reduction of \$632 from 2020 CDBG allocation and reduction of \$227 from 2020 HOME allocation.

Funding Source: HUD

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The CDBG and HOME programs have different focuses. CDBG funding is the most diverse funding stream. It provides decent housing and suitable living environments and expands economic opportunities, principally for low- and moderate-income persons.
- HOME funds housing projects, often in partnership with local nonprofit groups, including building, buying, and/or rehabilitating affordable housing for rent or homeownership or providing direct rental assistance to low-income people.
