# AGENDA HEADING:


# FISCAL IMPACT:

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Ashworth Pool and Northwest Pool Painting Improvements, Activity ID 11-2021-010. The improvement includes Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) crack sealing, PCC joint repairs, and painting; all in accordance with the contract documents, located at 101 SW 45th Street and 4915 Madison Avenue.
- The estimated construction cost is \$136,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this public improvement project is anticipated to start late 2021 and be completed by the beginning of summer 2022.
