### AGENDA HEADING:

Approving the purchase of one (1) additional hydraulic power unit with portable submersible pumps for use in the Sewers Division of the Public Works Department.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend purchase of one (1) additional power unit with portable submersible pumps per State of Iowa Department of Administrative Services contract number 16201E, from Central Service and Supply (Dan Abramovich, President, 4219 East 50th Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50317), in the amount of \$65,310.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$65,310

Funding Source: FY2021-2022 Operating Budget, Page 81, I201, Equipment Replacement.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The need for additional portable submersible pumping capacity was identified for routine and emergency operations and this additional power unit with two (2) additional submersible pumps and associated accessories and hoses was approved by the Fleet Oversight Committee as an addition to the fleet in the Sewers Division of the Public Works Department. The power unit is driven by a 74-horsepower clean burning diesel engine. There are no portable fully electrical driven pumping units available in this class of equipment.
