### AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of a purchase order for the procurement of a Tennant sweeper/scrubber for use at the new Municipal Service Center II.

### SYNOPSIS:

Approval of the purchase of a Tennant Model MM30 sweeper/scrubber for use at the new Municipal Service Center II.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$76,343.17

Funding Source: BL12800021 – MSC Phase 2 Equipment

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Municipal Service Center II includes 140,000 square feet of interior garage space that will require maintenance and frequent cleaning. Facilities Division requests the purchase of an industrial, ride on sweeper/scrubber.
- This equipment will help maintain the facility and improve its overall appearance by removing all the dust, road grime and salt left by vehicles coming in and out of the facility. It will be utilized to help reduce the dust within the environment created by vehicles bringing in large amounts of mud and debris. Keeping this environment clean and dust-free will help provide a healthier and safer space for City staff to work in. This purchase will be utilizing the Omnia Partners and WW Grainger Agreement as allowed per Municipal Code section 2-26(m).
