AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Evergreen Avenue Rehabilitation from Marion Street to SE 30th Court - Receiving bids, (11-2-21), and Setting date of hearing, (12-6-21). Construction Estimate - \$500,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council order construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for full depth patching and the resurfacing of Evergreen Avenue utilizing surface scarification and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay.

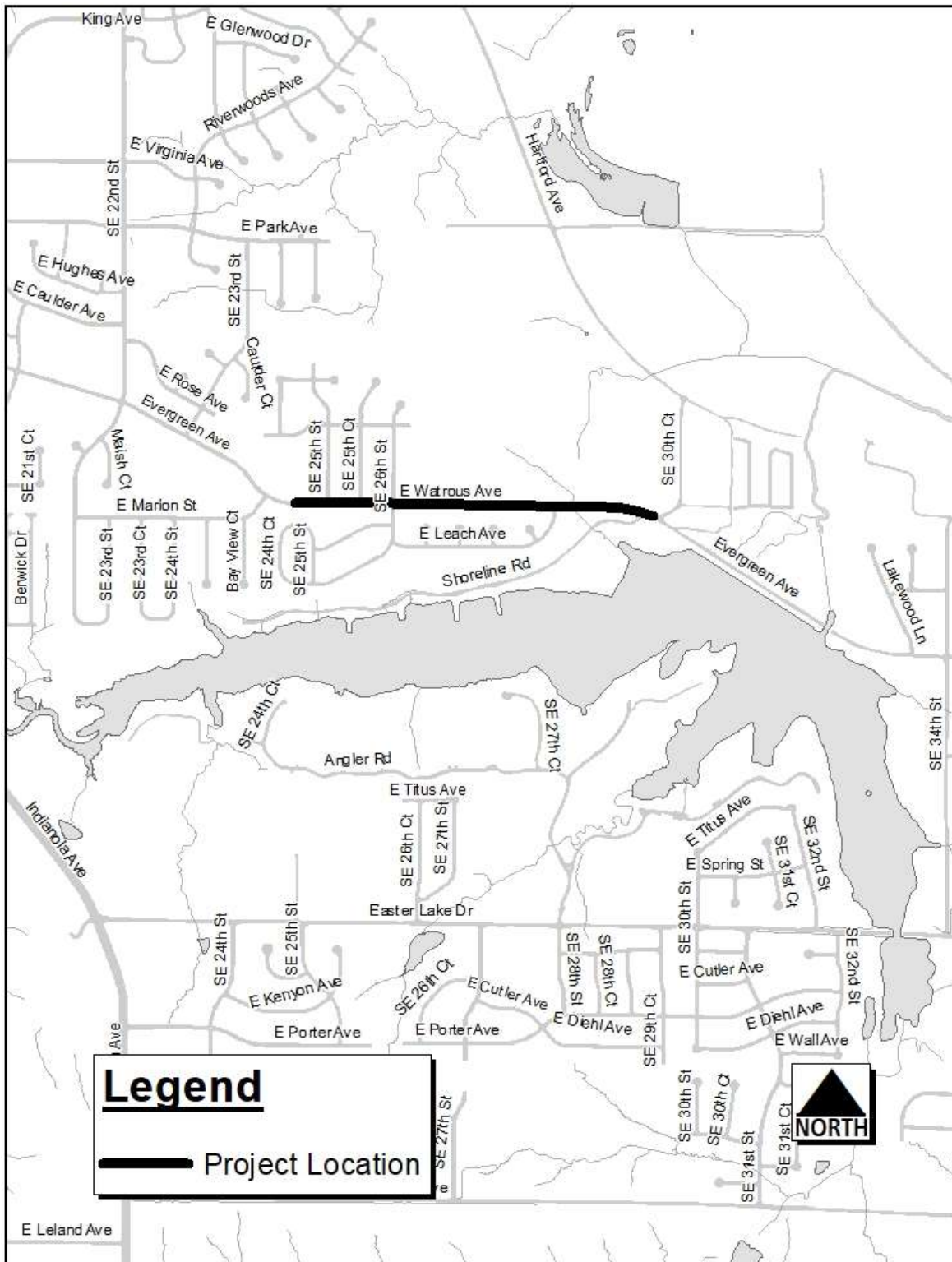
FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$500,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2021-2022 CIP, Page 143, Local Option Sales and Services (LOSST) Street Improvements, ST800, LOSST Monies.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Evergreen Avenue Rehabilitation from Marion Street to SE 30th Court, Activity ID 06-2019-021. The improvement includes scarification, furnish and place HMA pavement, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, pavement removal, traffic control, seeding, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File No. 635-001/034 located on Evergreen Avenue from Marion Street to SE 30th Court.
- The estimated construction cost is \$500,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this public improvement project is anticipated to start in the spring 2022 and be complete by fall 2022.
