
#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- This project provides replacement of deteriorated pavement for Observatory Road west of Polk Boulevard. The project also adds parallel parking along the south side of Observatory Road adjacent to the Waveland tennis court facilities and reconfiguration and improvements to the Waveland tennis court parking lot.
- At this time, the total property interests needed for this project consist of two (2) partial fee acquisitions and one (1) temporary construction easement, all to be acquired from two (2) separate property owners. Relocation assistance will not be required.
- The City of Des Moines will also need to grant a permanent water main easement to Des Moines Water Works for installation of a fire hydrant.
