### AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of the purchase of maintenance and support for Hewlett-Packard (HP) 3PAR 8400 storage arrays from OneNeck IT Solutions (Terry Swanson, President and CEO, 11191 Aurora Avenue, Urbandale, IA 50323), per State of Iowa Contract 16054, which is competitively bid.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the purchase of maintenance and support for Hewlett-Packard (HP) 3PAR 8400 storage arrays from OneNeck IT Solutions (Terry Swanson, President and CEO, 11191 Aurora Avenue, Urbandale, IA 50323), per State of Iowa Contract 16054, which is competitively bid. This purchase will keep these storage arrays under support with HP for security and maintenance issues, while the body camera system is moved to a cloud-based solution.
