### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with JEO Consulting Group, Inc. for additional design phase services for Indianola Avenue Reconstruction – E. Army Post Road to U.S. Highway 69, not to exceed \$62,020.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the PSA with JEO Consulting Group, Inc. (Robert S. Brigham, President, 142 W. 11<sup>th</sup> Street, Wahoo, Nebraska, 68066), for an additional amount not to exceed \$62,020, based on hourly labor rates and reimbursable costs, to provide additional design phase services for Indianola Avenue Reconstruction – E. Army Post Road to U.S. Highway 69.



# **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- This project provides for the reconstruction of Indianola Avenue from E. Army Post Road to U.S. Highway 69. The roadway will be improved to a two-lane urban standard with turn lanes and the construction of curbs and storm sewer and will provide a separate 10-foot wide shared-use trail on the west side of the roadway.
- On December 2, 2019, by Roll Call No. 19-1899, City Council approved the PSA with JEO Consulting Group, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$395,810, based on hourly rates, to provide engineering services for design phase services for reconstruction of Indianola Avenue from E. Army Post Road to U.S. Highway 69.
- Supplemental Agreement No. 1 provides for the following additional professional services:
  - o Additional sanitary sewer video and inspection.
  - Additional design phase services for additional improvements at the intersection of Indianola Avenue and U.S. Highway 69, including providing dual left turn lanes on Indianola Avenue approaching U.S. Highway 69.

- Additional design phase services for additional improvements at the intersection of Indianola Avenue and E. Army Post Road, including replacement of the existing eastbound right turn lane on E. Army Post Road approaching Indianola Avenue and removal of the existing acceleration lanes on E. Army Post Road in the northwest and southeast corners of the intersection.
- o Additional design phase services to include extended limits for the reconstruction of Bloomfield Road from Indianola Avenue to Meadow Chase Lane.
- o Additional work required to complete and submit Traffic Control Device application to the Iowa Department of Transportation necessary for signal timing revisions.
- Survey staking services for marking out the proposed storms sewer location for a Des Moines Water Works water main relocation.
- Survey staking services for marking out the proposed storm sewer for gas main relocation by MidAmerican Energy.
- Additional services during construction of the project, including pre-construction conference participation, shop drawing review and development of responses for design interpretation questions from the contractor.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to begin in spring 2022 and be fully completed in 2023.
