Receive and file the Public Works Stormwater Infrastructure Advisory Committee (SIAC) annual report regarding the status of community goals and receive comments from the committee chair.

SYNOPSIS:

As part of the Public Works SIAC policies and rules, the committee shall provide an annual report to the City Council on the status of the committee goals. The committee has drafted and finalized the report for submission to the City Council. The SIAC committee chair wanted to provide comments on the efforts of the committee in 2021.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The SIAC met four (4) times during 2021. They held their first two (2) meetings in February and May virtually due to COVID-19, in order to follow the Mayor's prohibition on indoor gatherings of 10 or more people on public property. The final two (2) meetings in August and November, were held in person.
- The committee membership remained robust and maintained eight (8) active members in 2021.
- The committee continued the work started in 2020 providing feedback to City staff on stormwater project prioritization, on capital budget process, on proposed stormwater ordinance/policy updates, on the stormwater master plan, and on stormwater public outreach efforts through website updates, social media postings, and engagement with the stormwater master plan public outreach efforts.
