### AGENDA HEADING:

Acceptance of proposal from MidAmerican Energy Company to install new LED streetlights for Indianola Avenue Reconstruction from E. Army Post Road to U.S. Highway 69, estimated at \$84,680.80.

### SYNOPSIS:

Recommend acceptance of proposal from MidAmerican Energy Company (200 SE 3rd Street, Des Moines, Iowa, 50309), to install new LED streetlights for Indianola Avenue Reconstruction from E. Army Post Road to U.S. Highway 69.

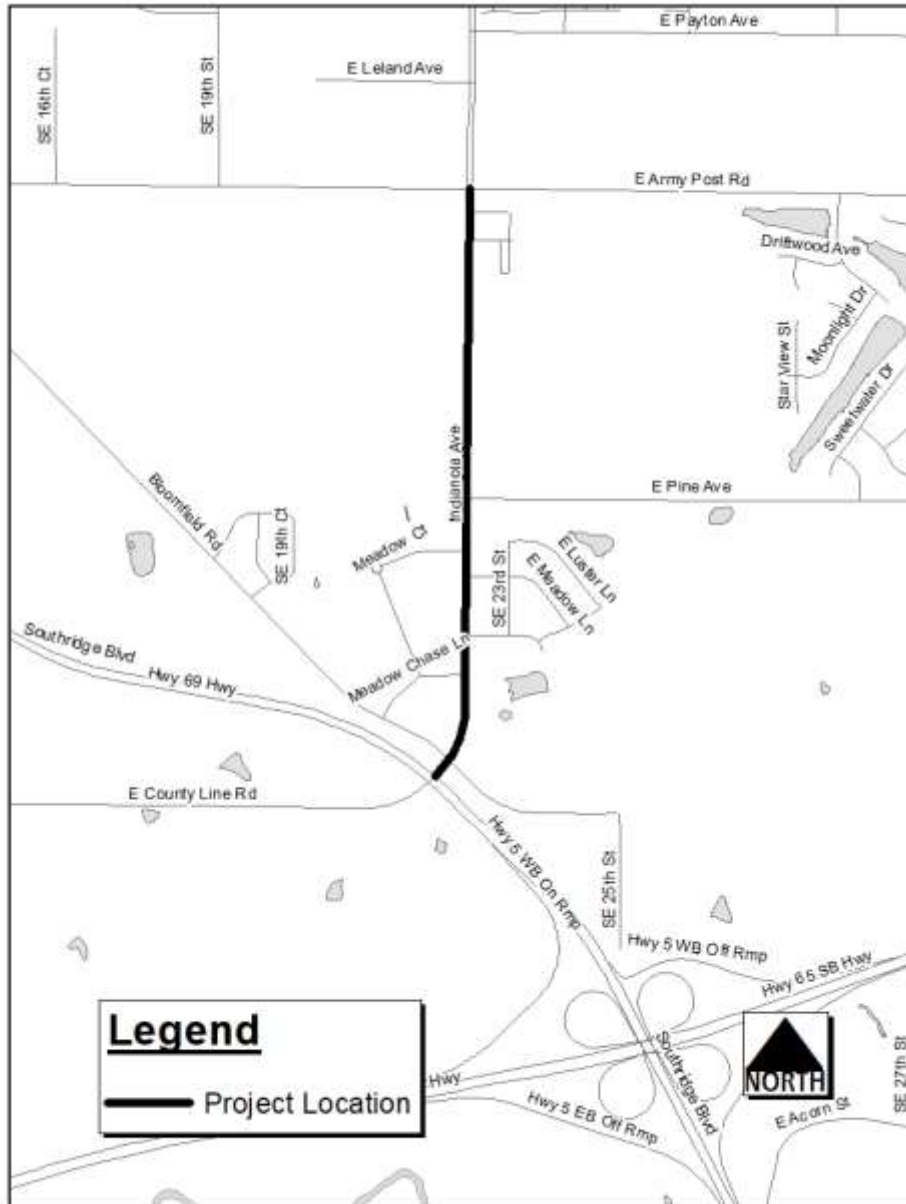
### FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$84,680.80

Funding Source: 2021-2022 CIP, Page 118, Indianola Avenue Improvements – E. Army Post Road to Hwy 69, ST264, GO Bonds.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Indianola Avenue Reconstruction project includes the reconstruction of Indianola Avenue with an 8-inch-thick Portland Cement Concrete (PCC), modified subbase, PCC sidewalks and driveways, storm sewer, intakes, subdrain, traffic signalization, pavement markings, traffic control, restoration, seeding, and miscellaneous associated work to complete the project.
- The project includes new street lighting. MidAmerican Energy prepared plans to install 50 poles with LED light fixtures along the project. The LED light fixtures will all be on wood poles along Indianola Avenue, except the lights at the intersection with U.S. Highway 69 will be on steel poles and the lights on County Line Road (leading to the MidAmerican Energy facility) will be on black steel poles. The lights installed on steel poles and served by underground conductors will be billed to the City at the wood pole, overhead rate.
