Recommend approval of the staff recommendation and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

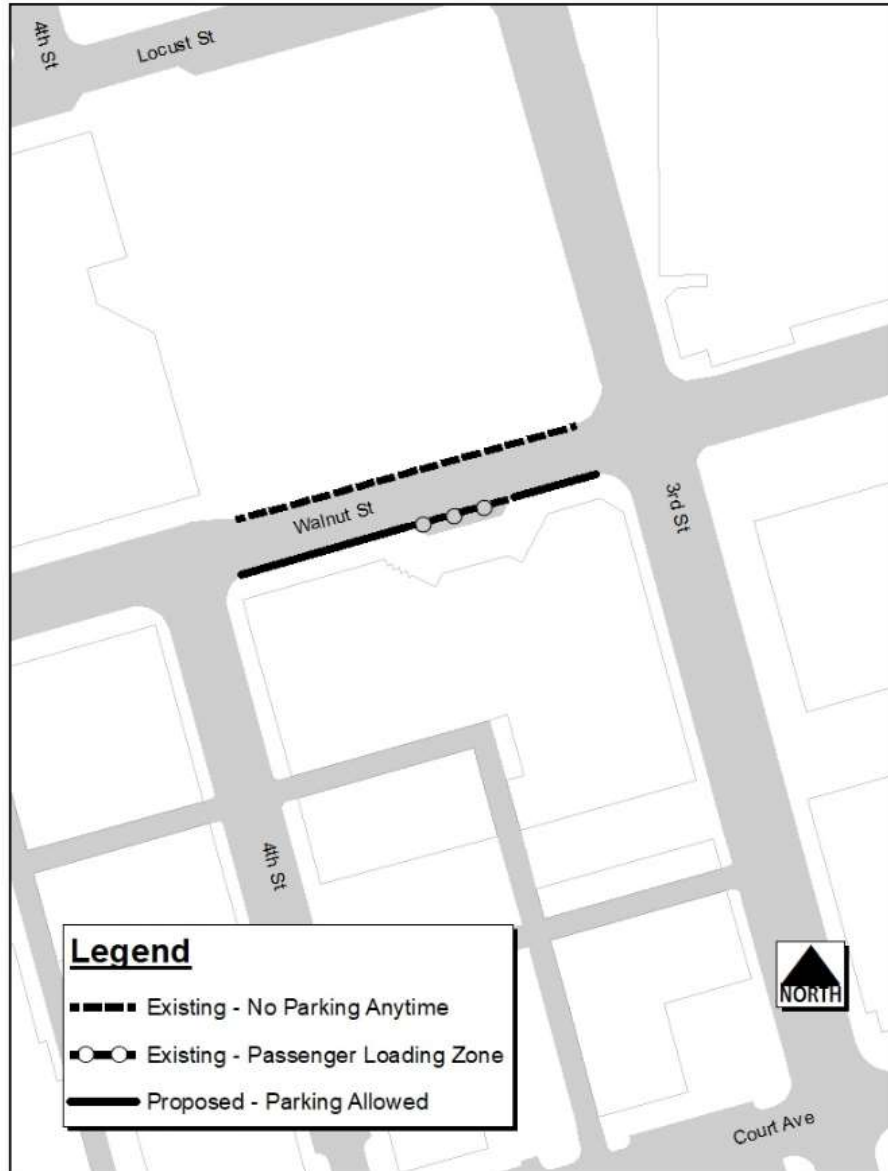
FISCAL IMPACT:

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Due to the addition of a curb bump out on Walnut Street at 4th Street, parking restrictions will be lifted on the south side of Walnut Street from 3rd Street to 4th Street to allow for additional parking. On-street metered parking will be placed in these areas.



Sec. 114-3734. - Walnut Street—Third Street to Fourth Street.

Walnut Street, on the south side, from Third Street to a point 40 60 feet west thereof, no parking any time.

Walnut Street, on the south side, from a point 85 60 feet west of Third Street to a point 75 55 feet west thereof, passenger loading and unloading, ten minutes only.

~~Walnut Street, on the south side, from a point 115 feet west of Third Street to Fourth Street, no parking any time.~~
