### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving the award of bid and purchase of one (1) Type 1 replacement ambulance for use by the Fire Department and approving of one (1) trade-in offer.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Approval of award of bid to Foster Coach Sales, Inc. (903 Prosperity Drive, Sterling, IL 61081), for purchase of one (1) Type 1 replacement ambulances and one (1) trade-in ambulance, purchased through the Houston Galveston Area Council (HGAC)Buy Public Safety Project.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- HGACBuy is a government-to-government cooperative purchasing program. Its enabling legislation allows for HGACBuy to act nationwide on behalf of local governments, and Des Moines is a member of the HGACBuy Public special districts and private non-profits providing a government service. HGACBuy's procurement process includes research, preparation of specifications, prebid and preproposal conferences, legal notice posting and advertising, bid/proposal review and contract execution. On March 9, 2022, the Fire Department received pricing proposal for one (1) Type 1 ambulances from Foster Coach Sales, Inc. bidding Horton Type 1 ambulances with trade-in offer for one (1) ambulance based on HGACBuy.
- Unit costs there is one (1) unit cost for the ambulance:
  - Ambulance 1 \$355,433, including Power Pro-XT Cot and Power Load System Installed
- Power loading system cost the unit cost per ambulance also includes the unit cost for Stryker Power Load Systems: \$28,898 each. This inclusion is the extended cost and is preferable to purchasing the ambulance without the loading system and later retrofitting the ambulance with the loading system.

- Stryker Power Load Systems (cot loading/unloading) is included and is standardized on all Fire
  Department ambulances in an effort to reduce back and other Emergency Medical Services
  (EMS) lifting injuries. After reviewing 2005-2018 data, it was determined the Fire Department
  experienced a 58% decrease in lost-time injuries as a result of the all-lift devices (Power Load
  System).
- Trade-in credit credit for one (1) 2012 F-450 4x2 ambulance being traded in at \$12,500.
- HGAC fee HGAC fee for one (1) unit purchases is \$1,000.
