# AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with I&S Group, Inc. for professional services for Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation Phase 3, for an amount not to exceed \$488,150.

### SYNOPSIS:

Approving the PSA with I&S Group, Inc. (Lynn Bruns, CEO, 115 E. Hickory Street, Suite 300, Mankato, Minnesota, 56001), for a total cost not to exceed \$488,150, based on hourly rates, to provide construction observation services for Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation Phase 3.


<u>Amount</u>: \$488,150

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2022-23 CIP, Page 99, Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation, SS139, Being: Sanitary Sewer Fund and Sanitary State Revolving Fund.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- This project provides for the separation of storm water flows from the existing combined storm and sanitary sewer system as part of the Long-Term Control Plan to meet the requirements of the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) and the 2010 IDNR issued Consent Order, Judgment, and Decree. The project will separate sewer flows generally between Grand Avenue on the south, 40<sup>th</sup> Street on the west, 35<sup>th</sup> Street on the east and Rollins Avenue to the North. This is the third and final phase of the Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation project.
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) for professional services for 2022-2024 On-Call Construction Inspection Services was issued and posted on the City's website. A selection committee of Engineering Department staff reviewed and rated the 10 proposals received in response to the RFP. I&S Group, Inc. was selected to provide services for this project based upon the selection criteria in the RFP and their project understanding and related project experience.
- City staff has negotiated a PSA with I&S Group, Inc. for a total cost not to exceed \$488,150, based on hourly rates, to provide construction observation services which includes observation of construction progress, quantifying constructed improvements for payment, engineer's periodic visits to observe and review the contractor's work, conducting progress meetings, and other related construction observation tasks.

• Construction of the Western Ingersoll Run Sewer Separation Phase 3 project is anticipated to begin in late spring 2022, with most of the construction complete by end of 2023, and surface restoration work complete by spring 2024.
